I na Makaainana o Honolulu.

Ua noi ia mai au e hapwi aku i ko'u inoa i lona makananana no ke kau Ahaolelo e hiki mai ana, a mahope iho o ka noonoo pono ana, ua ne'au au.

No keia mea, he pono ia'u ke hoai'ai iki aku i nua o oukou, i na poe nona na bilo i hooholoia e lilo i mau waha olelo no oukou, iloko o keia Ahaolelo ae.

Aole au he kanaka no ano koke iho nei ma keia pae aina. Ua hiki mai au maanei iloko o ka m. n. 1846, a noaila, he 27 o'u mau makihiki o ka noho makananana ana, no na Mo'i o Hawaii nei. O kou wahine mare, kou mau keiki a me na moopuna a'u mia-

nei no lakou i babau ia mi mai loke mai o ke koko Hawaii:

Āna au e komo ana i keia kau'o hiki mai, alaia, aole no ia be mea māli'hini ia'u. Oiai ma ka m. n. 1852, owau kekahi i kohoia i wahaolelo no ia kau, a oia hoi ka wa i noonoo ia ai ke Kumukanawaia o Kauikeouli, a mahope iho o ka noonoo loea ana, ua hoobolo ia; a ma ia kau no hoi ua hoopau ia kekahi mau auhao pilikino, a ma ka m. n. 1858, ua boouna hou ia no au i ka Ahaolelo; a ma ka m. n. 1858 ua kobo hou ia no au e hele i ka Ahaolelo, a ma ia kau hoi i hapai ia ai ke Kannwai Kirila. Ma ka'u mau hara ana a pau iloko o ka Ahaolelo, ua hooikaika mai su ma na pono a'me na pomaikai o na kanaka a me ke Kuokoa o keia Aupuni, ka mea a'u e kuena nei, oia ko'u home a biki i ka waiho ana o nei mau iwi i ke one o Kakui-hewa.

A ina oukou e nakui ana is'u e lilo i wa-haolelo no oukou, alaia, ke iaku nei su me ka bookamaemae ole, e hana no au a e hoo-ikaika hou hoi e like me ko'u hooikaika ana mamus, ioa kau i bala sku nei, ke hiki nae, ma ka hoemī ana i na suamo ko-i e kai nei maluna o na kanaka ilihope, a e hoobalike-

ike ooi i ka auhau, e ike me ka waiwai ana
a ilihune paha o kekahi, pela e mahuaehua ai
a e emi ai boi; sole i ike iki ia neia mes i
keia wa. Ma ka auhau e ike ia nei, on ko-
koke loa e like ka ooi o ka ukuna o ke ka-
naka ilihune me ke kanaka waiwai. Nolatia
o ka boobalike loa ia ana o ka auhau o ka
poe ilihune a me ka poe waiwai, he mes po-
no ole loa ia.

Mai manao mai nae oukou e na makan-
nana i keia hoomaikeike ana, he hapaime-
meue ana i ka'u hana e hanasaku ai; ala, he
mea webewehe wale ato no keia, iona oukou
e hoao ana ia'u aleila, p hooikatka noi no
su e hana i ka'u oihana.
