He panahi nui ma Santiago, Kili, a ua hiki aka ke poho i ke \$200,000. Pela hoi me ke ahi ma Indianapolis, a o ke poho he \$100,000.

Ma na hoike, ua hana ia maloko o Amerika huipnia ma ka hapaha mya o 1888, he 2,271 mile alanui hao.

He ahi ma ke taona Okalana Kaledoni, a ua hiki ke poho i ka \$100,000.
